Certification students must choose at least one content teaching field from the list of state-approved teaching fields. 24 hours of content coursework is required; 12 hours must be upper-level.

Certification Requirements

- Students interested in obtaining teacher certification must apply to the program during the sophomore.
- Pass Texas Higher Education Assessment (THEA) exam or meet exemption prior to enrolling in any teacher education courses.
- Students must maintain a 3.0 (B) grade point average (GPA) for all courses counted toward certification.
- Complete 45 hours of field-based experience in local secondary schools, in conjunction with course work.
- After all coursework is complete, students will participate in a semester long student teaching experience in a Texas public school under the
 direction of a cooperating teacher and Rice supervisor. Contact the Teacher Education Office for additional information.
- Complete and present a portfolio in Supervised Teaching.
- Pass appropriate TExES exams Pedagogy and Professional Responsibilities and Content Exam(s).
- Apply for Texas State certification when all requirements are completed.
- Students should refer to the General Announcements for additional information and requirements.
